For the teacher – read out loud:

Christmas → (Write the jumbled up word at the blackboard) trachmiss

Angel → I'm wearing a white dress, and I've got wings. I'm a messenger from God.

Star → I'm shining bright and you can see me high up in the sky in the night.

Candle → This is a light made of wax.

Present → These things are lying under the Christmas tree. They are wrapped with glossy paper.

Stockings → The children are hanging these by the fireplace. Santa is filling them with presents.

Father Christmas → Another name of Santa Claus.

Turkey → This is a big bird they are having for dinner at Christmas Day in England.
