It is Sunday. Liza and her family are going to the zoo. Liza has a younger brother. He is five years old, and his name is John. John loves to watch animals!

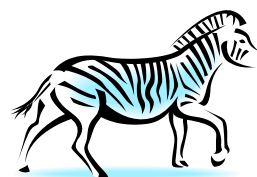
Dad: Liza, look! We have to walk across a zebra crossing to get to the zoo!

Liza: Do you know the difference between crocodiles and alligators, John?

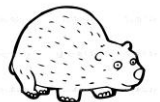
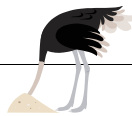
John: Yes! I know that crocodiles are bigger than alligators.
