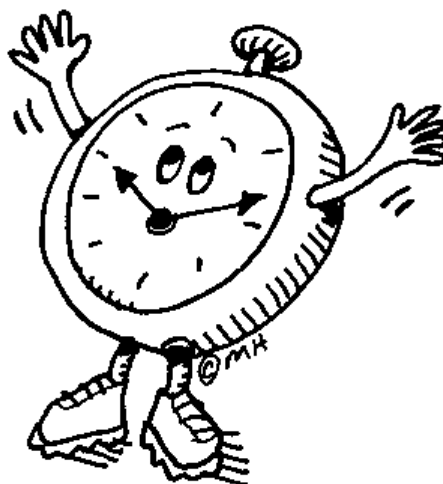


Tema 10: What time is it?

Math-problems:

Lea has twelve black shoes. Daniella has eight black shoes.

How many more shoes does Lea have than Daniella?

Answer:

Oliver has 60 football cards. Magnus H has 40 football cards.

How many more cards does Oliver have than Magnus H?

Answer:

Magnus F has 50 football cards. He loses 15 cards.

How many cards has Magnus F left?

Answer:

Milad has 60 football cards. He loses 20 cards.

How many cards has Milad left?

Answer:

Jeanette's house has eleven windows in it. Sofie's house has seven windows in it. How many windows do Jeanette's and Sofie's houses have in all?

Answer:

Marianne's house has eight windows in it. Karoline's house has nine windows in it. How many windows do Marianne's and Karoline's houses have in all?

Answer:

Sebastian buys 20 pencils. He uses eight of them.

How many pencils are left?

Answer:

Emilie buys 18 pencils. She uses nine of them.

How many pencils are left?

Answer:

Julie read seven books at school. Linnea read six books at school.

How many books did Julie and Linnea read in all?

Answer:

Christoffer read ten books at school. Eirik read six books at school.

How many books did Christoffer and Eirik read in all?

Answer:

Henrik buys five apples. Andreas buys seven apples.

How many apples did they buy in all?

Answer:

Jenny buys nine bananas. Kaja buys four bananas.

How many bananas did they buy in all?

Answer:

Wenche drinks four milk a week. Ingrid drinks six milk a week.

How many milk do Wenche and Ingrid drink in one week?

Answer:

Stian drinks six juiceboxes a week. Fabian drinks nine juiceboxes a week. How many juiceboxes do Stian and Fabian drink in one week?

Answer:

Martine sees 14 birds. Isabel sees 21 birds. Sine sees 17 birds.

How many birds did the girls see in all?

Answer:

Iver sees 35 birds. 16 birds fly away. How many birds are left?

Answer:
